

## **Anthony Schapira, MD DSc FRCP FMedSci**

Professor Anthony Schapira MD DSc FRCP FMedSci was appointed in 1990 as Chairman of the University Department of Clinical Neurosciences, at the Institute of Neurology, Queen Square and Professor of Neurology at the National Hospital and the Royal Free Hospital. He is Director of Research and Development, and Clinical Head of Service for Neurosciences at the Royal Free Hospital.

Professor Schapira's research interests include the molecular and clinical aspects of neurodegenerative diseases, with special emphasis on Parkinson's disease and other movement disorders. He has over 500 publications. Professor Schapira is the recipient of the Harveian Medal, the Royal College of Physicians Clinical Science Prize, the 1999 Opprecht Foundation Award, and the 1998 European Prize for Clinical Science. He was elected a Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences in 1999. He was awarded the Duchenne Prize in 2005.
