Irena Rektorova, MD, Ph.D. is an Assistant Professor in Neurology, First Department of Neurology, Masaryk University and St. Anne's Hospital, Brno, Czech Republic. Her clinical and research interests are in neuropsychiatric aspects of Movement Disorders and Parkinson's disease in particular, cognitive impairment and dementia. Her other interests include repetitive transcranial magnetic stimulation and functional imaging and its use both in the movement disorders and dementia. She worked as a Board Member of the EPDA (European Parkinson's Disease Association) between 1998- 2001 and as Vice-President of the EPDA, 2001- 2003. She has been Head of the Centre of Cognitive Impairment and Dementia of the First Department of Neurology in Brno since 2003 and Deputy Head of the Movement Disorders Centre since 2005.
