Howard Fillit, MD, is the founding Executive Director of the Institute for the Study of Aging and the Alzheimer's Drug Discovery Foundation, venture philanthropies advancing drug discovery for Alzheimer's disease and cognitive aging. A geriatrician and neuroscientist, Dr. Fillit is currently clinical professor of geriatrics, medicine, and professor of neurobiology at The Mount Sinai School of Medicine (NY). He has maintained a limited consulting practice in geriatric medicine in Manhattan for over 25 years. Prior to founding ISOA, Dr. Fillit was the Corporate Medical Director for Medicare at New York Life, responsible for over 125,000 Medicare members in several regional markets. He has received numerous awards, including the Alzheimer's Association's Rita Hayworth Award, and is the author of more than 250 scientific articles and the editor of several books including the leading international Textbook of Geriatric Medicine and Gerontology. Dr. Fillit also serves as a speaker and consultant for the pharmaceutical and biotechnology industries.
