

Martin Citron, Ph.D., is currently Team Leader Alzheimer's Disease Discovery Research at Eli Lilly and Company, where he leads an enduring team that directs AD research efforts from lead optimization through Phase II. Prior to joining Lilly in 2008 Dr. Citron was Executive Director Research, Neuroscience at Amgen Inc, where he headed the neurodegeneration research effort. Dr. Citron is best known for his research on the amyloid pathway in Alzheimer's disease, in particular the identification and characterization of β -secretase. Prior to joining Amgen in 1997, Dr. Citron was Assistant professor at Harvard Medical School. Dr. Citron received a Ph.D. in Molecular Biology from the Max-Planck Institute for Molecular Genetics in Berlin, Germany in 1990.
