

## **Martin Rossor**

Professor Rossor graduated from Jesus College, Cambridge and Kings College Hospital Medical School London. He trained in Neurology at the National Hospital, Queen Square and undertook research into the neurochemistry of degenerative disease at the MRC neurochemical pharmacology unit in Cambridge.

He directs the Dementia Research Centre at the Institute of Neurology. He established a specialist cognitive disorders clinic which acts as a tertiary referral service for young onset and rare dementias. Clinical research interests are in neurodegenerative disease and particularly in familial disease. He is honorary consultant neurologist at St Mary's Hospital and at the National Hospital for Neurology and Neurosurgery where he is Chairman of the Division of Neurology. He is editor of the Journal of Neurology Neurosurgery and Psychiatry and was recently appointed Director of the Department of Health Clinical Research Network for Dementias and Neurodegenerative Diseases (DeNDRoN).
