### TOUR AROUND THE CITY OF SANTIAGO – (HALF DAY TOUR)



(Daily 9 o'clock a.m. Regular service (3 1/2 hrs.)

Departure from the hotel. Tour around the colonial area of the city, Ejercito Av., Blanco Av., O'Higgins Park, Santiago Racetrack, Republica St., Bernardo Óhiggins Av., the La Moneda Presidential Palace (1786), Municipality of Santiago, old Palace of the Courts of Justice (1907), ex- National Congress (1858), Main Square (1870), Cathedral (1748), Central Post Office (1882), Mapocho Station Cultural Center (1905), Central Market (1868), Mapocho River, Parque Forestal, Palace Museum of Fine Arts, Santa Lucia hill, place of the foundation of Santiago on February 12<sup>th</sup>, 1541, National Library (1917), Municipal Theater (1853), Baquedano Square with the Grave of the Unknown Soldier, Bohemian district of Bellavista, famous for its restaurants, San Cristóbal hill (880 m.s.n.m), Costanera Av., Providencia St., Suecia Av., El Bosque Av., Isidora Goyenechea Av. and Borderio, excellent gastronomic centers, Vitacura Av., Apoquindo Av. and the Military school.

## CULTURAL SANTIAGO – (HALF DAY TOUR)



(Daily except Monday) (Private service only) (Admission to the Museums included)  
(3 1/2 hrs.)

Departure from the hotel. Tour to the Chilean Museum of Pre-Columbian Art. Opened in 1981 by the Familia Larraín Echeñique foundation, owner of the collection that is exhibited, and the Municipality of Santiago that opened the building as a museum. The collection consists of 3,000 pre-Columbian pieces, ceramics, textiles, paintings and sculptures showing the evolution of the American Man and his different cultures divided by areas – South Andean (Chile, Argentina, Brazil), Andean (Peru, Bolivia), Intermediate (Ecuador, Colombia), Mesoamerican (Mexico). Convent and Museum of San Francisco built between 1572 and 1628, showing a rich collection of colonial art, 54 pictures of great proportions (180x290 cm), done specially for the corridors of the cloister representing the life and miracles of Saint Francisco. The specialists consider it as the best Cuzco painting sample of the continent. Also a beautiful collection of locksmith shop of the XVI, XVII and XVIII centuries can be appreciated, which show the technical perfection of the Hispano-American locksmiths. Cousiño palace built between 1870 and 1878 by the French Paul Lathaud for a well-off Chilean family. The palace dazzled the Santiago society of the time for its magnificence, as well as for the introduction of technical advances, the first elevator made in Chile was installed here. The main materials of the building, iron coatings, parquet, grates, enamelled stoneware and all the furniture, were brought from Europe, along with the craftsmen who installed them. The excellent quality of the construction and decoration has maintained this building intact for more than a century.

## **CRAFTSMEN TOWN OF LOS DOMINICOS – LOS GRANEROS DEL ALBA - (HALF DAY TOUR)**

Departure from the hotel towards the residential zone of Los Dominicos. Tour to the cosy Craftsmen Town Los Graneros del Alba, immersed in the Chilean colonial architecture of the 1800. Goldsmiths and jewellers give texture to metals and precious stones; clays and ceramics acquire special colours and beauty in the treatment of the mud furnaces, fine leather completions, beautiful looms and wool of authentic indigenous traditions and varied objects of collection of the Latin American colonial time.

## **CONCHA Y TORO VINEYARD – (HALF DAY TOUR)**



(Visits only with reservation) (3 1/2 hrs. total time)

Departure from the hotel. The trip is towards the locality of Pirque, bordering the Valley of the Maipo, a zone that stands out because it concentrates the most traditional vineyards of Chile and that is, because of its characteristics, the ideal zone for the production of the most elegant red wines. Concha y Toro Vineyard, was founded by Marques de Casa Concha in 1883. Nowadays the vineyard has more than 750 hectares of vineyards in different areas of the region elaborating noble Chilean wines of French vine stock as the Cabernet Sauvignon, in addition to Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Merlot, Pinot Noir, Gewürztraminer and others. Tour to the park, vineyards and fermenting room.

### **COUSIÑO MACUL VINEYARD – (HALF DAY TOUR)**

(Monday through Friday. Saturdays only in the mornings. Sundays and some holidays closed) (Visits only with reservation) (Private service only) (3hrs. total time)

Departure from the hotel. The trip is towards the locality of Quilín in the commune of Peñalolen, towards the mountain range. The Cousiño Macul Vineyard is the oldest plantation of vines in Chile. It belonged to Juan Jufré, companion of Pedro de Valdivia, who received it in 1546 as a payment for his services during the Conquest. It was already exporting wines to Peru in 1550. After many owners, it was acquired by Matías Cousiño in 1856, whose son, Luís, and his wife, Isidora Goyenechea, imposed its present character of noble stocks and hired European enologists. The visit includes a route by the old fermenting and aging rooms and the process of the bottling.

### **UNDURRAGA VINEYARD – (HALF DAY TOUR)**

(Monday through Friday. Saturdays only in the mornings. Sundays and some holidays closed) (Visits only with reservation) (Private service only) (3 1/2 hrs. total time)

Departure from the hotel. The trip is made along Route 68 in a beautiful trip by rural landscapes of the Chilean countryside until arriving at the Undurraga Vineyard. Founded in 1885 by Francisco Undurraga Vicuña, an eager connoisseur of Europe and who, in one of its trips, brought Riesling stocks from Germany and Sauvignon blanc, Cabernet franc, Merlot and Pinot Noir from France. In 1885 under the supervision of the French technician Pressac, he carried out the first plantations and which are the only pre-Phylloxera grapevines in the world. He also had special preoccupation in the manufacture of his vessels made by the French Perranau with American oak from Kentucky and oak from Bosnia. The tour includes a visit to the production process of the wine starting off with the bottling, labelling and vinification, as well as to the park designed by the French landscape designer Pierre Dubois

## ISLA NEGRA – (FULL-DAY TOUR)



(Daily 9 o'clock a.m. Private service) (8 hrs. total)

Departure from the hotel. The trip is made through the del Sol Freeway, going along the coast of the Pacific ocean through the resorts of San Antonio, city-port and supply center for all the coast to the south of Valparaiso. Cartagena, a beautiful place where the hills fall steep to the sea leaving a small warm beach and a bay. In this town-resort great and large old houses of fantastic style were built, one next to another, form the streets that raise to the top of the hills. Las Cruces, old resort that reflects the splendour of the beginning of the XX century. Isla Negra, place where our poet and Literature Nobel Prize winner Pablo Neruda lived. Tour to his tomb, his house and museum (closed on Monday), with his collection of large masks of prow and diverse nautical objects. El Quisco with its pedestrian promenade that goes along the whole beach to continue towards Algarrobo, one of the most beautiful and most visited resorts of the area. Located in a well covered road on which hills elegant summer houses are located. Its sea is calm and all kinds of aquatic sports are practiced here and it is the host of the main nautical races of the coast. There is a yachts club and the Nautical Brotherhood of the Pacific, in an artificial lagoon that shelters the greatest boats of the country, located at the side of the rock Peña Blanca where, depending on the season of the year, the Humboldt penguins live.

The summer dresses the mountain range with a different beauty generating great possibilities for the adventure and the exploration, strolls in chairlift, excursions and horse riding tours. For the lovers of nature, the mountain range offers a unique spectacle, that is only possible to see three thousand meters high and in summer season.

During the morning, visit to Rano Kau volcano, (1,6 km in diameter), the ceremonial village of Orongo with the largest concentration of Petroglyphs with images of Tangata Manu, the birdman, gods Make Make and Komari, fertility symbols and Vinapu. Time off for lunch. In the afternoon, sightseeing tour of Ahu Akivi, site of the seven Moais overlooking the sea, the Caves of Ana Tepahu, among the largest on the island and Pun-a-Pau quarries on the slopes of a volcano and where the reddish topknots were sculpted. Return to the hotel. Lodging.
