Chile is a country with a history of seismic activity. The country's preparedness, including its strict antiseismic building codes, the rapid emergency response from the government as well as the help from a number of organizations can be credited for managing the situation and help minimize the damage. The country's tourism infrastructure has, overall, fared well, reporting little damage.

Santiago's International Airport is now operating 95% of scheduled flights. National carrier LAN Airlines reports that they are currently operating 85% of regularly scheduled flights in and out of Santiago including domestic and international flights. North American carriers Air Canada, Delta Air Lines, and American Airlines have all resumed flights to Santiago.

The hotels in Santiago are all working and operating 95%. They haven't reported any major damages to their structures and receiving guests with all normality.

Our main destinations (Atacama, Santiago and surroundings, Easter Island, Lakes and Volcanoes and Patagonia) are all operating regularly without any problems.
