He received his law degree from the Autonomous University of Ciudad Juarez, being admitted to practice law throughout the Mexican Republic since 1989.

In 1997 he obtained his Master of Laws Degree from the School of Law of the University of Texas at Austin.

He was the President of the Mexican National Association of Corporate Lawyers, Chihuahua Section, from 1998 to 2000 and he was also a member of the National Board of that Association.

He was a teacher of Private Law at the Institute of Technology and Higher Studies of Monterrey (ITESM), Campus Juarez, for five years.

In the public sector, he was appointed as General Director of Non-Conformities of the Ministry of Public Function (MPF) from May 2001 to April 2003.

Finally, on January 2007 he was appointed as the General Under Director of Water Administration of the Mexican Water Commission.
